







How is the Baltimore Police implementing the Governor's Executive Order for non-essential businesses?

Any officer that observes a business or receives a complaint that a business is in violation of the Governor's Executive Order must investigate the complaint.

The officer shall:

-  • Assess whether a violation exists
- Contact Vice on radio channel 12A and advise them of the violation
- Vice will investigate the complaint

If Vice is not available:

-  • Speak to the business owner/manager and inform them that they are in violation of the order and explain the need to comply for public health and safety reasons
-  • Provide the business owner/manager with a copy of the order
- Attempt to obtain voluntary compliance
-  • Email Vice at vicetips@baltimorepolice.org with the business name and location and they will conduct a follow-up investigation

Only Vice has the authority to shut down an establishment.
